Health Education England (HEE) is responsible for ensuring that there are high quality learning environments for all healthcare learners, to this end they launched their Strategy and Quality Framework in 2016. They recognise the significant impact of educational leadership and culture within an organisation has on the experience and outcomes of learners and on the empowerment of patients in their care. JFJ worked with HEE to develop toolkit to map training standards for pre-registration pharmacists in community pharmacy. This was tested by some tutors last year and the findings will be discussed at the workshop in relation to how best to prepare students for the future as the pharmacy workforce works in a more integrated way across sectors for the benefit of patients.
